ATTENDANCE

Attendance is an important to your child's learning, confidence, and sense of belonging at school. When your child misses school they miss opportunities to learn and grow! If your child needs to be absent, please be sure to notify the school office so we know they are safe.

Wisconsin Law states that a student may not miss more than ten days in a school year. If a student brings a note from a medical provider, dentist, orthodontist, etc. Wonewoc-Center Schools does not count that day toward absences.


BASE

WINTER BREAK



ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL REMINDERS

Wonewoc-Center School doors open at 7:35. Please refrain from dropping off students before then for the safety of everyone since there isn't supervision prior to that time.

I included a map of our parking lot with intended traffic flow. This flow was created with safety in mind. You may park in the parking lot on the playground side of the school and walk your child to the front door. You may also drop your child off in the drop-off lane. Please do not get out of your car if you are in the drop-off lane to allow for efficiency. Regardless if you park and walk your child to the front door or use the drop-off lane, please enter and exit from Center Street/Hwy 33. The School Road entrance/exit should be used by high school students and buses only. The cemetery side of the parking lot should only be used by high school students as well to help with flow and safety.
