## **SUMMER SCHOOL**

Summer school catalogs will be shared with students the week of April 7<sup>th</sup>! We will be offering both remedial and enrichment courses along with the traditional summer recreation and swimming opportunities. We are going to streamline the process this year so there will only be one form for summer recreation and traditional summer school.

Traditional classes will run Monday through Thursday with morning and afternoon sessions. Session 1 will be June 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> and June 16<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup>. Session 2 will be August 11<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> and August 18<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup>. We will also have make up days for swim lessons on June 13<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> and August 15<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> if increment weather cancels lessons during the regularly scheduled time.



## STATE TESTING

As mentioned last month, Wonewoc-Center Elementary students in grades 3-5 will take the Forward Exam in English language arts (ELA) and mathematics. Fourth grade students will take science and social studies tests as well. The Forward Exam is an online summative assessment that measures what students know in relation to the Wisconsin Academic Standards. We will test Wonewoc-Center Elementary students on April 7<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup>.
