STATE TESTING

The Forward Exam is a part of the Wisconsin Student Assessment System and is a required assessment for all students. Wonewoc-Center Elementary students in grades 3-5 will take the Forward Exam in English language arts (ELA) and mathematics. Fourth grade students will also take a science and social studies tests as well. The Forward Exam is an online summative assessment that measures what students know in relation to the Wisconsin Academic Standards. We plan on testing Wonewoc-Center Elementary students on April 7th-11th.
